The meeting was called to order.

I. The meeting was Called to Order by Albert Suhu at 7:01 PM.

II. Annual Election:

- A. Al Suhu motioned to postpone the election. Dennis Chan seconds the motion. No objection. The motion passed unanimously.
- B. Council voted to schedule the election for October 13, 2022, due to members' absences, Al Suhu motioned to approve the election to be held on October 13. The motion passed unanimously.

III. Superintendent Report:

- New Vision HS Superintendent Richard Cintron
- Superintendent Cintron provided an update on Bayside HS and Bayside HS admission policy.
- Council advocated for adding an extension and requested a partnership with Superintendent Cintron to ensure access and prioritize zone HS students in District 26.
- New York State Student State Data: (see addendum A)
- **School Bus apps -** District 26 buses will be installing GPS systems in D26 buses to ensure access for families to track via an app of the bus.
- Superintendent shared information about middle school admission. The mayor and chancellor have provided a platform to return to screen schools.
- District 26 students can now apply to screen programs in D26 as before the pandemic.
- Superintendent Giunta shared information about middle school open houses.
- There will be also SLT training in D26 end of this month. Superintendent shared information about Queens North Safety Command Forum.
- District 26 also works with diagnostic tools and is more accessible to students to focus on the core curriculum.
- District 26 workshop updates.
- **Dilip raised questions about how are we supporting the students that are failing.** Superintendent addressed the questions in thinking about how are we engaging our students in their core curriculum and ensuring that teachers are being trained to support the students that are failing.

IV. Vote on filling vacancy for ELL Member:

- Two candidates applied for the ELL vacancy. Ms. Yandong Sun and Mr. Louis Tsai were interviewed on October 11, 2022, at a Special Meeting.
- President Council District 26 recommended Ms. Sun as the preferable candidate for District 26 ELL vacancy.

Al Suhu motioned to vote on candidates. The motion was seconded by Dennis Chan. Vote: Yandon Sun: Dilip Nath, Al Suhu, Sulinda Hong, Dennis Chan, Jennifer Catherall. Louis Tsai: Todd Friedman

The vote did not pass for the ELL vacancy.

 - Since Mr. Tsai withdrew his candidacy, Al motioned to vote for the ELL vacancy again.
 - Mr. Friedman raised an objection stating that we cannot motion for the same items on the agenda again.
 - FACE representative Federoff clarified that the council can add items to the agenda as long as there is a second motion.
 - Mr. Friedman objected stating that since there is no written communication regarding it and members cannot change the vote for any of it on the same night till we have it in writing from FACE.

The meeting was called to order at 9: 50 PM.


- I. **Review of minutes from September 8, 2022:** Albert Suhu motioned to approve the minutes and the minutes is approved unanimously.

- V. **Members Report:** Dilip and Dennis shared information about sitting on Citywide Committee for Remote Learning.


Al Suhu motioned to adjourn the meeting at 10:08 PM and the motion passed unanimously.




